

**CHINA WIRELESS TECHNOLOGIES SUPPLIES 6,000
“COOLPAD 858C” SMARTPHONES
TO BEIJING ADMINISTRATION FOR INDUSTRY AND COMMERCE**

**CAPITALIZING ON GOVERNMENT’S MOVE TO RAISE ADMINISTRATIVE EFFICIENCY
BOOST SALES TO INDUSTRY APPLICATION MARKET**

(Hong Kong, 5 June 2005) – China Wireless Technologies Limited (“China Wireless Technologies” or the “Group”) (stock code: 2369), China’s leading developer and marketer of wireless system solutions and wireless terminals, announced that it has won a contract to supply 6,000 “Coolpad 858C” smartphones to the Beijing Administration for Industry and Commerce (“BAIC”). The smartphones will be connected with BAIC’s information system to form a mobile platform for law enforcement in the food market, raising the department’s administrative efficiency.

Mr. Guo Deying, Chairman of China Wireless Technologies, said, “The smartphone supply contract with BAIC is another important government contract we landed, following the smartphone supply contract with Shandong Province’s public security bureau last year. The smartphones will greatly help law enforcement departments raise administrative efficiency. On the other hand, the contract is significant to us as it helps to reinforce the Group’s leadership in the industry application market, creating a win-win situation for both parties.”

Armed with the mobile platform for law enforcement, BAIC law enforcers can access information of business entities under investigation on the smartphones anytime, anywhere. By keying in the companies’ registration numbers and names, the law enforcers can view such data as registration of the companies for establishment, closure and license cancellation; the identity of their legal representatives, investors, key executive and location of their branch offices. Other accessible data include the companies’ status in annual reviews by the BAIC, and their case histories including such information as the date when the case was filed, the nature and facts of the offence or crime and the kind of penalty imposed. All these enquiries can now be carried out anywhere using the smartphones. It saves the BAIC from the trouble of having to mobilize personnel and move large quantity of suspicious goods to the headquarters for further investigation. This enhances the efficiency of law enforcement and administration.

The CDMA supported “Coolpad 858C” smartphone helps corporate customers enhance their administrative efficiency. The smartphone is equipped with dual-CPU (central processing units) for processing data at high speed. It is also fitted with a 2.8 inch, 260,000-pixel color TFT LCD (thin-film-transistor liquid-crystal-display) monitor that accommodates touch-screen input, and a 128M-memory module to support China Unicom’s “U-Net” Service, which allows wireless Internet access at 153.6k per second. Equipped with a video camera (1,300,000-pixel) with a built-in flash bulb, the smartphone allows law enforcers to send real-time images of the crime scene to the headquarters, where the decision makers can then respond and issue orders promptly. “Coolpad 858” series can also adapt to proprietary wireless data platforms designed for different sectors, ranging from public security, logistics to securities trading, offering a “mobile office” to enhance efficiency and management levels.
