

**CHINA WIRELESS TECHNOLOGIES WINS SECOND CONTRACT FROM CHINA UNICOM TO SUPPLY
90,000 CUSTOMIZED
“COOLPAD 858” DUAL-MODE SMARTPHONES
TAPPING SURGING DOMESTIC DEMAND**

(Hong Kong, 28 August 2005) – China Wireless Technologies Limited (“China Wireless Technologies” or the “Group”) (stock code: 2369), China’s leading developer and marketer of wireless system solutions and wireless terminals, announced that it has won the contract to supply 90,000 “Coolpad 858” dual-mode smartphones to China Unicom. This is the Group’s second smartphone supply contract with the telecommunications carrier. The entire new order will be delivered by phases within this year. The Group delivered the first order for 30,000 “Coolpad 858” dual-mode smartphones to China Unicom early this year, when it became the first domestic wireless terminals supplier to provide the telecommunications carrier with dual-mode smartphones.

Mr. Guo Deying, chairman of China Wireless Technologies, said, “The volume of the second order for smartphones the China Unicom has placed with China Wireless Technologies is three times that of the first supply contract with the telecommunications carrier. This shows that there is a huge domestic demand for the Group’s proprietary “Coolpad 858” dual-mode smartphone. China Unicom will supply the smartphones to government bodies and corporate clients from various industries as well as high-end users. This proves the Group’s technological advantage and its close partnership with China Unicom.”

The “Coolpad 858” dual-mode smartphone targets the industry applications market and high-end users in China, allowing users to switch between CDMA and GSM networks and access roaming communications, and thus be able to work anytime and anywhere. The smartphone is equipped with dual-CPU (central processing units) for processing data at high speed. It is also fitted with a 2.8 inch, 260,000 pixel color TFT LCD (thin-film-transistor liquid-crystal-display) monitor that accommodates touch-screen input, and a 128M-memory module to support China Unicom’s “U-Net” Service, which allows wireless Internet access at 153.6k per second. The “Coolpad 858” can also be adapted to proprietary wireless data platforms designed for more than.
